Fine Print for Writers:

- Poem/prose should be no more than a page long

Fine Print for Performers:

- Performance should be no longer than 5 minutes
- Performances can be spoken word, dance, music – whatever you are inspired to do once you read your assigned writing

- Your written "assignment" will be provided when you sign up so you will have a few days to prepare
