Exploring Watercolor and the Figure

Workshop on October 19, 2011, 2-5pm

Alexandria, VA (September 6, 2011) - Are you intimidated by watercolor? Join us for this introductory workshop to explore using watercolor to paint the figure. Diana Gamerman is the instructor.

Diana is a working artist who graduated from George Washington University and received her art education locally at the Corcoran School. She frequently exhibits her work at the Arlington libraries.



Diana will begin with a short talk on different types of watercolor paint, mediums, paper and brushes. Participants will then have a chance to experiment with these different materials as we paint from a live nude model. Diana will show examples of watercolors by Picasso, Matisse, Van Gogh and Wayne Thiebaud as well as demonstrate her bold, loose painting style during the workshop.

This workshop is ideal for beginners and those that want a refresher on using watercolor. All supplies will be provided. The workshop fee is \$18 for Del Ray Artisans members or \$20 for non-members.
