**Alexandria, VA (June 25, 2012) -** Del Ray Artisans Board of Directors presents *Boarderlines*, an exhibit showcasing artwork by six members of the Board: Kathryn A. The exhibit is an individual and group journey across "boarders" and features a silent auction, 2-D and 3-D gallery artwork, and take-away art. - Kathryn A. Brown, Director of Membership: Heads her own photography business specializing in events and architecture; and composes personal photographs ranging from abstracts to Americana, exploring the details of the natural and man-made worlds.
- **Drew Cariaso, Director of Curating**: Sculpts the human form in motion, expressing a mood; experiences the inspiring, magical, love for sculpting in-and-of itself; and dabbles in photography.
- **Michele Reday Cook, President**: Works in watercolor and oil to create portraits and landscapes of places she has lived; translates life experiences into more representational and abstract works; and captures the figure in clay.
- **Lesley Hall, Director of Volunteers**: Paints abstract images and landscapes using colors that would otherwise be... enemies.
- **Dawn Wyse Hurto, Director of Technology**: Creates painterly, figurative art celebrating how the line and brushstroke can breath life.
- **Nora Partlow, Director of Community**: Shares her passion for gardening through her photographs of favorite flowers in her perennial garden.
