Alexandria, VA (released: August 4, 2013) - This all-area artist show at Del Ray Artisans gallery is about defining and depicting the 1% of anything each artist chose in a representational, abstract, or symbolic form in any media (2D/3D). Initially inspired by F. Scott Fitzgerald's novel The Great Gatsby regarding the wealthy 1%, the concept grew to include something overlooked or unnoticed, natural resources, indigenous cultures, achievement of happiness, a grain of sand or a drop of water etc. It could be the 1% of something the artist saw, felt or wished for; or what 1% of something looks like today, yesterday or tomorrow. Come find the 1% that inspires you!
