Del Ray Dozen Invitational Photography Show at Del Ray Artisans

Alexandria, VA (released: October 1, 2013) – Del Ray Artisans (DRA) is pleased to announce the return of the “Del Ray Dozen Invitational Photography Show” running from November 1 through December 1, 2013. Come to the opening reception on Friday, November 1, from 7-10 pm—and prepared to be WOW-ed! The reception will include a silent auction of photography pieces created by “the Dozen.”

The thirteen photographers—whose subject matter ranges from landscapes to portraits and a little bit of everything in between—are each given a distinct, separate space in which to display a full body of work or concept.
